Frequently Asked Questions

Why is the facility use fee being implemented?

 The annual facility fee has been adopted to help support the daily operational expenses of the NRH Senior Center.
 The projected revenue will support 9% of operational costs.

What does my annual NRH Senior Center facility fee cover?

 This fee partially supports daily operations of the senior center and participation in existing events and programs that do not currently incur a fee.

Do other Senior Center program fees and donations continue to be collected?

• Yes, if a program has an existing fee, those fees will continue to directly support that individual program.

When is the annual facility fee due?

The NRH Senior Center facility fee is an annual fee.
 The expiration date of your paid fee is one year from date of purchase.
 The NRH Senior Center annual facility fee will be available for purchase beginning December 16, 2019.
 Existing Senior Center members will not need a new blue facility card.

How much are the fees?

The NRH Senior Center facility fee for NRH Residents
is \$10 per person annually (proof of residency required).
 The facility use fee for Non-Residents is \$30 per person annually.
 The facility fee term is one year from the date of purchase.
 Guests without a NRH Senior Center facility card can pay a daily use drop-in fee of \$3.
